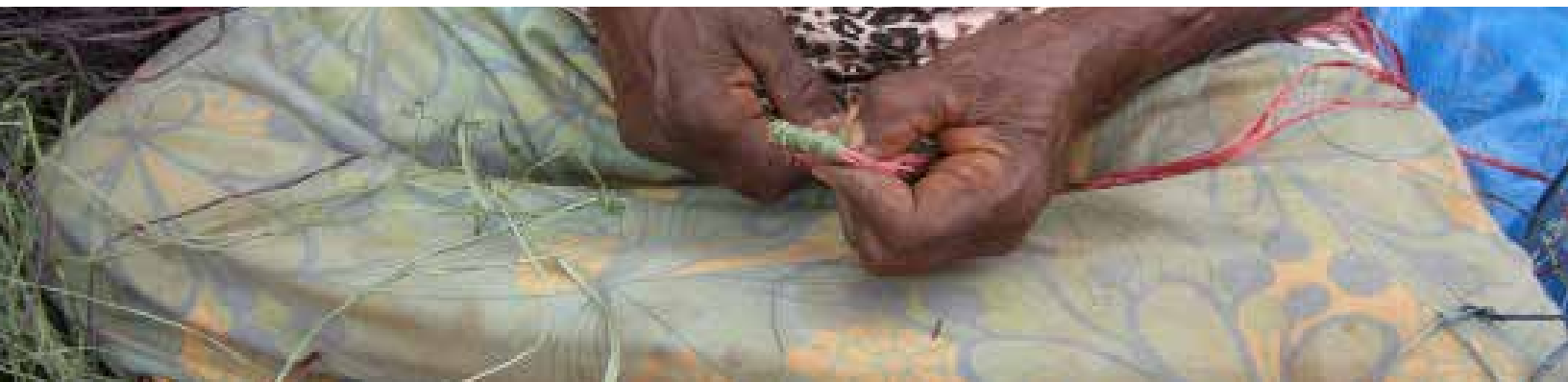


Di Borella
